Who is this clinic for?

Adult Health Clinics are free clinics that are held at various locations throughout Stark County. They are available for anyone age 18 years and older.

What do they do at this clinic?

A Public Health Nurse provides individualized:

- Blood Pressure Screening
- Health Education
- Referral to physicians and agencies
- Medication discussion
- Discussion on medical topics pertinent to adult health
- Socialization with other adults
