School and Community Clinics for Tier 1 Priority Groups

Tier 1 Priority groups are defined as:

- Pregnant women
- Health care workers and first responders with direct patient care
- People who live with or care for infants under the age of 6 months
- Children between 6 months through 24 years of age
- Individuals 25 years of age through 64 years who have chronic medical conditions that put them at a higher risk of influenza related complications.

These vaccines are at no charge to the public. Both H1N1 FluMist (nasal) and H1N1 flu shots are available for those that are eligible. This schedule will be in effect as long as the vaccine is available.

- **School based clinics are for the students ONLY. High school and middle school clinics are being held in the first three weeks in November.**
- **The evening elementary clinics are for those families of children attending the elementary school in that district that are in Tier 1 only. It is also for those students and families in Tier 1 that attend a private or parochial school in that district.**
- **The community clinics are for those that are in the Tier 1 Priority Group only.**
