

Where can I get my H1N1 flu vaccination?



Initial doses of H1N1 vaccine will be offered to individuals who are in the high risk categories below:

- Children 6 months thru 24 years of age
- Pregnant women
- Healthcare providers and Emergency Medical Services Personnel
- Caregivers and household contacts of infants under the age of 6 months
- Individuals 25 years of age thru 64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza related complications.

Eventually there will be enough vaccine for all residents of Stark County.

Many physician's offices, health departments, and pharmacies have ordered H1N1 vaccine. Vaccine is currently being shipped and offices will begin offering vaccinations when enough vaccine is available.
